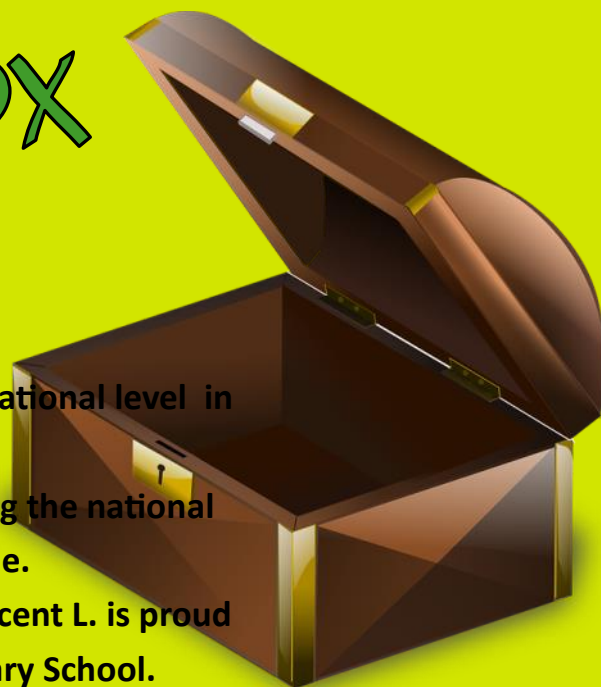
★ Sixth grader Dhruva was a part of a team that reached the state level in robotics.
