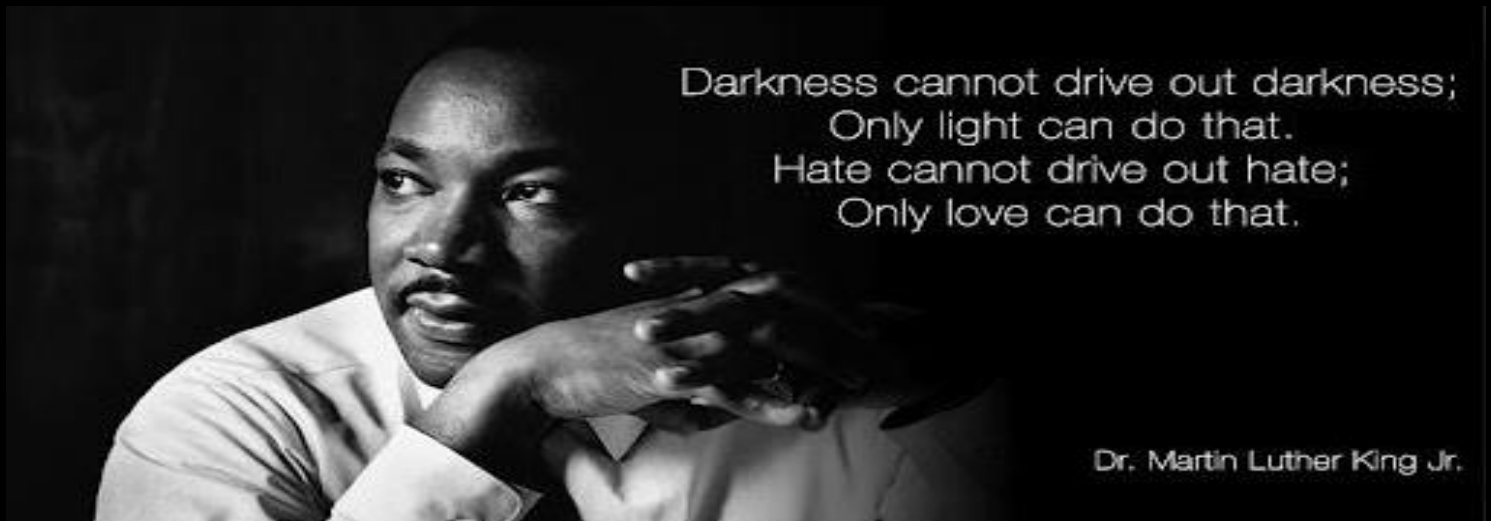

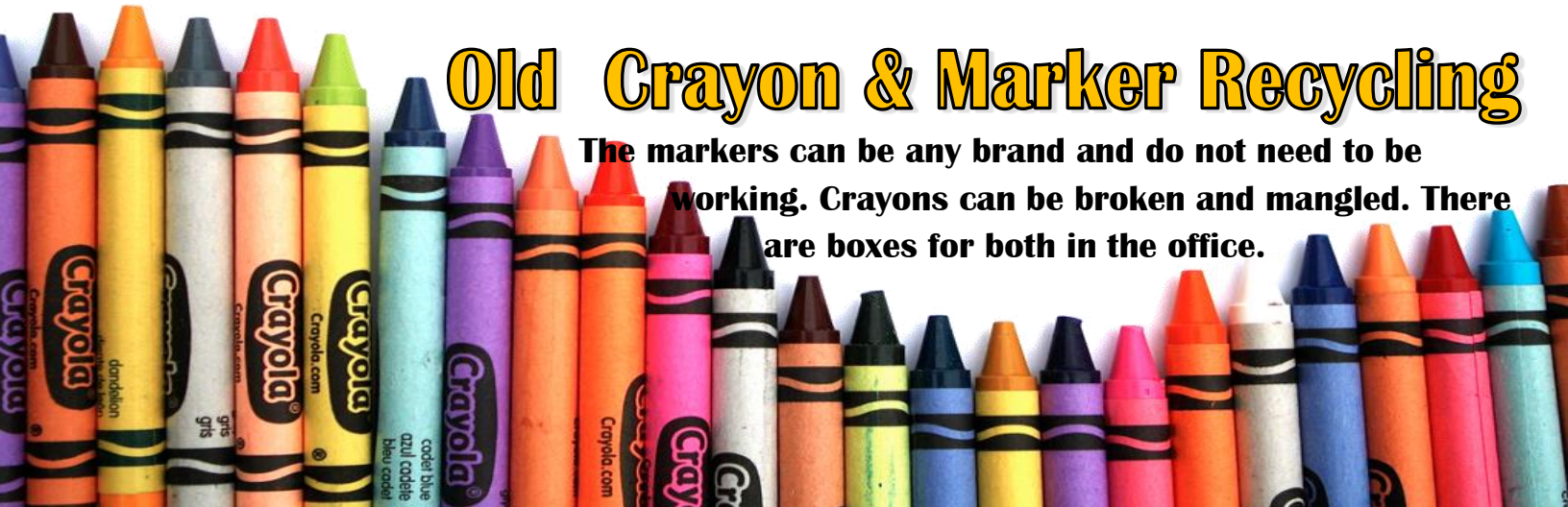
Achievement Box
